Meet Needs of Changing Community Demographics

- January 2024 Membership Special included \$0 Enrollment and no January payment. 236
  new members took advantage of this promotion to join Fountain View Fitness with an
  individual or family annual membership, paying monthly. As a comparison, in 2023 there
  were 130 new members in January.
- Before & After Care has 818 school year registrations compared to 860 this time last year. 946 daily flex passes have been sold year to date compared to 1,019 last year. The program is serving 226 individual registrants.
- Fountain View Concessions was open every Saturday in January for Youth Travel Basketball League Games and Swim Meets.
   Total gross revenue for January is \$1,932.
- The Dolphins Swim Team logo was revamped to meet brand standards with the appearance of a competitive edge.



#### **Develop Parks and Facilities**

- Community Park work will commence the week of February 19 if weather remains positive. The first thing Construction Inc. will be working on are the completing the shelters. Once the weather is consistently in the 40's they will shift focus to the futsal court.
- Walter Park the contractor will begin bringing in equipment on, or around, February 26. Submittals have been rolling in, playground equipment will arrive by March 1 at the latest and the project should be completed by the Fourth of July.

# Foster a Safe and Welcoming Environment

- Staff is exploring pricing to add locks to the 'inside' of doors so that staff can lock down program room/classrooms in cases of an emergency without having to lock the door with a key from the outside.
- Preschool Supervisor attended the Preschool Information Fair at the Carol Stream Library on January 27. Supervisor spoke with 20 families about the park district preschool program and handed out information about the upcoming school year and preschool open house.

• The Registration & Membership Services team have been working on a project of updating fitness memberships, to streamline the number of options based on Recreation team's direction.

- Participation numbers in popular group fitness classes continue to increase.
- Train for 5K! and Martial Arts Conditioning were offered for winter 2024, increasing interest and participation in our registered fitness class programs.
- Members enjoyed the addition of Flashdance to the 80's Fun Fitness Class on January 25.



- The 500 Mile Challenge began on January 1 and has 124 members participating. 16 members have reached the first milestone of 125 miles.
- The February Member Challenge began on February 1. Members are challenged to work out 14 times at Fountain View Fitness during the month of February for a chance to win a \$50 gift card; 141 members are participating in the challenge.
- The 3rd Annual Dolphins Swim-a-Thon took place on January 29 and 30, raising \$3,472 which will go towards the Dolphins Fundraising Account. A record board will be purchased in 2024.
- 5-Star Soccer will be running a youth soccer coaches clinic along with a player clinic scheduled in April. This is a new opportunity for coaches and players. They will also be running a youth summer soccer week-long camp at Red Hawk.
- CSPSC will be running our youth soccer player evaluations for our in-house soccer league in March at Glenbard North. They will be running our U10 and U12 soccer participants through drills while our in-house coaches rate the participants for the upcoming draft.
- Super Bowl basketball tournament was held with 12 teams.
- Our adult dodgeball league was canceled earlier this season, but we will be offering a shortened season to build the program back up. League will start in March, and continue for 6 weeks, and will be offering it as a co-ed league.
- Youth Baseball/Softball program will be offering fundraiser nights with the White Sox, June 30 and Schaumburg Boomers, May 24.
- Springers Gymnastics Team competed at Tumbling Sectionals on February 3. There were five teams and approximately 100 tumblers. Team results: 1st place – Newcomer, 2nd place – Beginner, 1st place - Advanced Beginner 1, 2nd place - Advanced Beginner 2, 1st place - Novice 1. There were also 12 Sectional champs!

- Staff is currently completing mandatory annual Fraud Awareness training to be completed between January-February.
- Staff is also completing mandatory bi-annual Cybersecurity training to be completed in February.
- Preschool Supervisor is attending the Illinois Association for Supervisor & Curriculum Development Conference from February 29-March 1.
- Two summer Recreation Interns have been hired. Payton Schmidt is graduating in May from Elmhurst University with a degree in Business Administration & Sports Management. Matt

- Georgoulis will be going into his Junior year at Illinois State University and is pursuing a degree in Recreation & Park Administration.
- A Before & After Care staff meeting was held on February 7. Highlighted topics included activity, ePACT, and general procedure reminders, and a lead-specific training. There is continued focus on consistency between sites.
- Two full time parks employees attended Maintenance Management School in West Virginia put on by NC State University.
- IMRF has updated their website and has a new procedure for us to report and pay IMRF earnings. HR staff attended Zoom trainings with IMRF to learn the new process and new features of the Member Services section of the website.
- Registration & Membership Services Manager will be joining monthly marketing meetings with Recreation staff to stay informed and updated about registration matters.
